#### Description

The summer international travel program is designed to provide students with a direct experience in modern and historic built environments. Peru provides the grounds for studying Inca, Spanish colonial, and modern design as well as providing unique examples of historic landscape design. Native American ruins provide a rich landscape for studying pre-Columbian, colonial and vernacular Peruvian design and urbanism.

#### Course Structure

This three credit course will consist of maintaining a daily journal, participating in studio projects and attending field trips, or do directed research on a topic. Field trips and lectures will be conducted by tour leaders or local professionals.

#### Course Requirements

Everyone taking the course for credit will be required to complete the following assignments which will be evaluated for the course credit under LA 4063 during the summer of 2010.

- Students while in Mexico will be required to participate in field trips and the UDLA charette problem.
- Students will maintain a daily journal, develop an photo graphic essay or sketch book of built works viewed.
- In Peru, students will be required to participate in classes of sketching, model building, and earthen architecture, a studio project, group tours and field trips.
- Students shall present a program on their studies in Peru to the LA classes or to the PAC the following Fall semester and submit their journal and sketch books before July 1, 2010.
- Non design students wishing to do a research report shall identify a research topic before departure and conduct independent research while in Peru and maintain a daily journal.
- Following the students return to the U.S., a research paper will be due by July 1, 2010.

**ALL APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2010 PROGRAM MUST BE RECEIVED BY FEBRUARY 23, 2010** at which time participants will be notified of final program cost currently estimated to be \$1900 for the Peru program plus airfare of approximately \$1000 plus tuition. Study abroad trip insurance of \$25 is mandatory. There is a possibility that several \$500 scholarships will be available to students through the study abroad office. Full program fee or a deposit of \$500 plus airfare will be due by **February 25, 2010** with the balance due **March 31, 2010**.

#### Eligibility

Participation is open to all students, alumni, friends of the Horticulture and Landscape Architecture Department, or School of International Studies, and other interested persons. However, if the course is oversubscribed, preference will be given to OSU students. The maximum enrollment will be 15.
