Fee: \$250 per individual

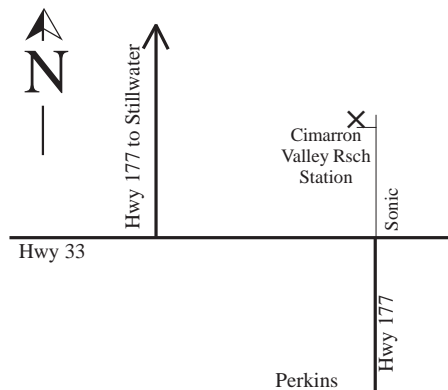
Format: Discussion and practical exercise with optional web based study component.
