Overview of the Course

Graduate Seminar is an independent study course. There are no scheduled classroom lectures. Requirements are satisfied utilizing Desire2Learn (D2L) course management software and by presenting a departmental seminar.

Participation in Graduate Seminar and Enrollment in HORT 5020

The following students will participate in graduate seminar using the “Communities” section of D2L (Graduate Seminar: HORTLA) during semesters when they present a departmental seminar.

- Masters students presenting their proposal seminar- not enrolled in HORT 5020
- Masters students presenting their results seminar- enrolled in HORT 5020
- Ph.D. students presenting either proposal or results seminar- enrolled in HORT 5020

All graduate students presenting a seminar during the semester will self-enroll in “Graduate Seminar: HORTLA” in the “Communities” section of D2L. Simply click on the “Self Registration” tab at the top of D2L and provide the requested information.

All graduate students presenting a seminar during the semester will also enroll in HORT 5020 via SIS **except** for masters students presenting their proposal seminars.

All course content is located in “Graduate Seminar: HORTLA” in the “Communities” section of D2L.

Grading

Ph.D. students will receive independent grades for both HORT 5020 enrollments. Masters students will receive one grade during the semester they enroll for HORT 5020, however, the grade will be an average of the activities completed during the semesters of their proposal **and** results seminars.
